What do you do as a conference assistant?

As a conference assistant, you act primarily as a host on behalf of the organization. You will help speakers, participants, exhibitors and other guests with all their questions and in finding their way in the venue.

Other responsibilities:

- Registration desk: helping participants with picking up their conference badge and other materials (lanyard, program etc.);
- Host(ess)/guide: guiding participants in the right direction, answering any questions and providing information;
- Poster assistance: helping participants find the right poster board and/or attaching the posters to the poster boards;
- Access control: control access and welcome participants at the (session)rooms and at social events;
- (Session) room assistance: welcoming the chairpersons and speaker and support them as needed. You will also walk around with a microphone for questions and answers during the sessions;
- Additional help to the organizing team when needed.

- Feel comfortable in an international environment;
- Like to help people;
- Preferable available every day (but not a requirement).
